This association was organized and certified by the United States Bowling Congress on 15 March 2005 as the Greater Killeen Fort Hood United States Bowling Congress (GKFHUSBC). 138 members who attended the initial organization meeting elected Vernon "Gene" Orr elected as the first president and Phyllis Gatliff was hired as the first Association Manager. There are currently 96 lanes in three local bowling centers Killeen Bowlerama, Hallmark Lanes, and Phantom Warrior Lanes within this association.
