I would like to urge all members to remember our area merchants who advertise in the association yearbook. The support each business provides to our association is invaluable and each business should be commended for an outstanding job.







FINANCE (Mandatory Committee)

Responsible for developing and preparing the annual budget, based on input from all other committees; perform (as a minimum) a quarterly and annual audit the Association Manager's records; and plan, organize and direct fundraising efforts, to include BVL, in conjunction with other committees. <u>This committee shall consist, as a minimum, of 3 members of the board of directors.</u>

NOMINATING (Mandatory Committee)

Responsible for soliciting, screening and recommending qualified and interested nominees for the board of directors and recommending a slate of officers to the general membership. They shall further solicit, screen and recommend delegates for the state and national annual meetings. **Members of this committee shall not be members of the Board of Directors.**

YOUTH (Mandatory Committee)

This committee shall initially be the current members of the KFHYABA Board of Directors. They shall be responsible for all aspects of youth bowler recruitment and development as well as planning, organizing and directing the activities of youth bowler related activities. They shall also recommend changes to the Youth dues structure to the board of directors. They shall further conduct the annual youth championship tournament in coordination with the tournament committee.

COMMUNICATIONS

Responsible for publicity both within the bowling community as well as within the community in general. They shall be responsible for construction and maintenance of an association web site and shall publish and distribute a newsletter, at least quarterly, to the membership.

HOUSE REPRESENTATIVES

Serves as this association's liaison with each bowling center, its proprietor, its league officers and its bowlers on all matters pertaining to the proper conduct of sanctioned league bowling. Responsible for the dissemination of information to its members, the promotion of association events to include its annual championship tournaments, and for the distribution of all national and local awards to the membership through one associate director volunteer from each sanctioned league. Further responsible for inspecting and certifying centers within the jurisdictional area and documenting all honor scores.

LEGISLATIVE

Responsible for reviewing and recommending changes to the association Bylaws and the Policy & Procedures Manual and prepare those documents for publication and distribution; organize all actions pertaining to suspensions and reinstatements; and report U.S.B.C. rules changes to the general membership; serve as parliamentarian at all meetings of the board of directors.

MEMBERSHIP

Responsible for establishing an active recruitment and retention program designed to increase membership; conduct educational seminars for league officers; plan, organize and direct Learn-to-Bowl and Learn-To-Bowl-Better clinics for interested members; and reviews league playing rules to ensure they conform to U.S.B.C. Rules. Further, they shall be responsible for the hospitality program.

RECOGNITION

Responsible for determining criteria and requirements for various association awards; recommending awards program policy; soliciting competitive bids for purchase of the various awards; maintenance of honor score plaques; and timely distribution through the house representatives, of all awards. Further, they shall be responsible for all aspects of the Hall of Fame program and other such awards as deemed necessary by the board of directors, to include Bowler of the Year and Merit and Achievement awards.

SPECIAL EVENTS

Responsible for the compilation and production of the annual yearbook, to include solicitation of yearbook advertisements. Further responsible for conduct of the Scholarship program to include recommending policy; implementing procedures; soliciting and reviewing all applications; recommending recipients to the board of directors; and coordinating presentation and appropriate publicity related thereto. Further responsible for the planning, organization, and conduct of the annual banquet and Christmas party.

TOURNAMENT

Responsible for the planning, promotion, organization and conduct of the annual championship tournaments, and other tournaments as specified by the board of directors, the awards presentations related thereto, and all average re-rating procedures related thereto. They shall further assist the Youth Committee in the planning and conduct of the annual youth championship tournament.

GREATER KILLEEN FORT HOOD UNITED STATES BOWLING CONGRESS BOWLING HISTORY

This association was organized and certified by the United States Bowling Congress on 15 March 2006 as the Greater Killeen Fort Hood United States Bowling Congress (GKFHUSBC). 138 members who attended the initial organization meeting elected Vernon "Gene" Orr was elected as the first president and Phyllis Gatliff was hired as the first Association Manager. There are currently 96 lanes in three local bowling centers Killeen Bowlerama, Hallmark Lanes, and Phantom Warrior Lanes within this association. KILLEEN FORT HOOD BOWLING ASSOCIATION BOWLING HISTORY

This association was organized and chartered by the American Bowling Congress in September 1958 as the Killeen Bowling Association. Len Munson was elected as the first president and Bill Bukovic elected as the first secretary-treasurer by 33 members who attended the initial organization meeting. In 1981, the organization was renamed the Killeen-Fort Hood Bowling Association. In 1988, the Coryell Bowling Association was inactivated and its members were integrated into this association. Initially, the only center in this association was Killeen Bowlerama. With the integration of Fort Hood into this association in 1982, it included Bowlers Green and Albee Lanes. In 1987, Hallmark Lanes opened to make the fourth center. In 1999, Albee Lanes closed and in 2001 Phantom Warrior Lanes opened on Fort Hood replacing Bowlers Green. There are currently 96 lanes in three centers within this association. On March 15, 2005, this association, along with the Killeen-Fort Hood Women's Bowling Association and the Killeen-Fort Hood Young American Bowling Alliance merged into the Greater Killeen-Fort Hood USBC Association, ending its 47 year existence as a separate membership organization. In 1988, the Copperas Cove Womens Bowling Association was inactivated and its members were integrated into this association. Initially, the only center in this association was Killeen Bowlerama. With the integration of Fort Hood into this association in 1982, it included Bowlers Green and Albee Lanes. In 1987, Hallmark Lanes opened to make the fourth center. In 1999, Albee Lanes closed and in 2001 Phantom Warrior Lanes opened on Fort Hood replacing Bowlers Green. There are currently 96 lanes in three centers within this association. On March 15, 2005, this association, along with the Killeen-Fort Hood Women's Bowling Association and the Killeen-Fort Hood Young American Bowling Alliance merged into the Greater Killeen-Fort Hood USBC Association, ending its 52 year existence as a separate membership organization. Suzie Wollek was selected by Texas Young American Bowling Alliance as the 2006 Texas YABA Meritorious Service Award. Suzie is one of the most involved and dedicated individuals to the sport of bowling you will ever meet and we are very fortunate to have her working with us and for us. Her dedication to bowling began in 1961 when she started bowling at the age of eight and her passion for bowling sparked a lifetime of volunteerism where she has served the bowling community in countless capacities. After becoming a coach in 1971. Suzie devoted thousands of hours to the bowling community, serving in various positions in the association, at the state and national level. The level of her commitment is truly exemplified when one realizes that she took on these volunteering responsibilities in addition to being a full-time Executive Secretary, Wife, Mother, and Grandmother. In her career, she has served as a center Youth Coordinator, Association Director, Association Secretary/Treasurer (Executive Director). Association Vice President, Association President, Tournament Director, In-State Instructor, In-State Coordinator, and Texas State Representative. And what a contribution she has made. From 1982-1996, Suzie was a member of the Austin association and the Youth Coordinator at Westgate Lanes. From 1996 to present, she has served as the Assistant Youth Director at Phantom Warrior Lanes. Served as Killeen-Fort Hood YABA Executive Director from 2000-2005. She has recruited and trained youth and adult coaches. She created and published a weekly center newsletter She has recruited new youth bowlers through a "Bring-A-Friend" program. She ensures that all youth bowlers in her care participate in charitable organizations. At Westgate Lanes, youth bowlers collected toys and canned goods for "Blue Santa", donated turkeys, and collected over \$9,000 in donations for the Children's Miracle Network. At Fort Hood, she encouraged youth bowler to collect toys and canned goods for the Fort Hood Santa Workshop and Killeen Food Bank. She assisted in the establishment of the Thanksgiving Scholarship Tournament and Scholarship fund for Phantom Warrior Lanes Bowlers. As of 2005, over \$2,600 has been awarded. She started a Bowler of the Month and Bowler of the Year recognition program. She assisted in establishing an end-of-year tournament and scholarship fund. She assisted youth bowlers financially so they can attend local or state tournaments. She worked state tournament in both Austin and Killeen and assisted adult membership organizations with their tournaments. She was Head Scorekeeper for the Columbia 300 Pro-Am tournament and trained over 200 volunteers to assist with that national PBA tournament. She assisted with the formation of the Austin Coaches Council and Austin Youth Leaders and initiated our local Youth Leaders organization. She realized a dream of establishing a scholarship at the center level when Rick Payson established the Chad Payson Memorial Scholarship Fund at Westgate Lanes in Austin. She was recognized by the Texas YABA as the 1996 Texas Volunteer of the Year for her contributions to the youth bowling community and selected to serve as Texas State Representative for the Western Region because of her dedication to youth bowling. She established a website to effectively communicate with parents and youth bowlers. She attended YABA International Workshops. She prepared scholarship packets for high school juniors and seniors. She ensured that all bowlers were placed on teams for city and state tournaments. She ensured that the President's Volunteer Council for their volunteer work recognized all Fort Hood volunteers. Along with her commitment to weekly youth leagues, she exhibited the same loyalty to tournaments, meetings and bowling programs. 




