- <u>ANNUAL TOURNAMENT</u>. The Annual Youth Handicap Championship Tournament of the Central Texas USBC Association shall be certified by the USBC and consist of a 3game individual even. Side events may be offered onsite for scholarship funds.
- <u>ELIGIBILITY.</u> The tournament shall be open to all youth bowlers in good standing with USBC and have a current USBC card for the 2023-2024 season.
- 3. <u>DIVISIONS</u>. There are three divisions for each this event based on averages.

4. <u>HANDICAP AND ENTERING AVERAGES</u>. The handicap allowance shall be 100% and be based on the difference between each bowler's entering average and 220. Each bowler's entering average shall be based on the following priorities:

Rule A – Bowlers will use the Central Texas USBC Tournament Average if number of games meets the required 21game minimum.

Rule B - Bowlers will use the highest verifiable **2022-2023** USBC book average of at least 21 or more games or composite **2022-2023** USBC average with a total of at least 21 games bowled whichever is highest..

Rule C - If Rule A, or B does not apply. Use the highest 2023-2024 current league average of at least 9 games as of date of participation. Bowler must provide league standing sheet..
Rule D – If A, B, or C, does not apply use the highest 2021-2022 verifiable average of at least 21 games or composite 2021-2022 verifiable average with a total of at least 21 games whichever is highest.

Rule E – All others will bowl scratch.

5. <u>AWARDS</u>. Awards shall be returned 100% for the event. There will be at least 1 prize for each 8 entries. Scholarship funds will be given as awards and submitted to SMART accounts. In the event of a tie, funds will be split amongst the two entries.
