## Youth Nomination Criteria

### HALL OF HONOR:

Eligibility:

- 1) Must be an eligible youth bowler prior to August 1 of the nominating year. **Transcripts are** required to determine the student's G.P.A.
- 2) Nominees must have been a member of a certified youth bowling program for 4 years with the last 3 years in a certified Texas youth bowling program.
- a) Nominees must provide verified current 21 game average.
- b) Nominees shall be judged on the following:
- c) Scholastic average and participation in other activities (school, church, community)
- d) Bowling achievements League, participation in Local, Regional, State, National and Special Tournaments
- e) Offices held in leagues and associations
- f) Honors or awards in bowling or other organizations
- g) High Individual games and series
- h) General attitude and number of years in youth program
- i) No more than three letters of recommendation are required
- 3) HOH induction is considered a once in a lifetime award.

Outside letters of recommendations are required.
